- Shredded Paper
- Computer and Copy Paper
- Posters and Folders
- Colored Paper

DO NOT PUT IN THE BIN ☹️

- Plastic
- Glass
- Metals
- Trash
- Bathroom or Kitchen Paper
- Phone Books
- Laminated Paper
- Food Containers and Milk Cartons
